## JUNE RED MEAT PRODUCTION 15 PERCENT GREATER THAN A YEAR EARLIER

Commercial production of red meat during June in the 48 States was 2,581 million pounds--up 15 percent from a year earlier and 1 percent more than the previous month, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Commercial meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other commercial plants but excludes farm slaughter.

## JANUARY-JUNE RED MEAT OUTPUT UP 8 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR

There were 15,641 million pounds of red meat produced during the first six months of 1964, an increase of 8 percent from the corresponding period of 1963. Of the January-June total, 8,833 million pounds were beef, up 13 percent from a year earlier; 411 million were veal, up 2 percent; 6,042 million were pork, up 3 percent; and 355 million pounds were lamb and mutton, down 4 percent. Lard production for January-June was 1,224 million pounds, up 2 percent from the same period a year earlier.

During the six-month period, the number of cattle slaughtered was 11 percent more than in the same period of 1963; calves about the same; hogs, up 1 percent; and sheep and lambs, down 4 percent.

## BEEF PRODUCTION UP 21 PERCENT FROM PREVIOUS YEAR

Beef production during June was 1,587 million pounds--up 21 percent from June 1963 and 5 percent above May 1964. The number of cattle slaughtered during June was 2,680,300 head, 22 percent greater than a year earlier and 7 percent more than a month earlier. The average live weight of cattle slaughtered in June was 1,022 pounds per head, 7 pounds less than June 1963 and 14 pounds below May 1964.

## VEAL PRODUCTION UP 18 PERCENT FROM A YEAR EARLIER

There were 72 million pounds of veal produced during June, 18 percent more than a year earlier and 11 percent more than a month earlier. The 517,000 head of calves slaughtered during June was 16 percent above June 1963 and 6 percent more than May 1964. Calves slaughtered during June averaged 247 pounds per head live weight, 9 pounds heavier than last year and 8 pounds heavier than last month.

PRODUCTION OF PORK 5 PERCENT MORE THAN JUNE 1963

Pork production during June was 867 million pounds--5 percent more than June 1963, but 6 percent less than May 1964. The hog kill for June was 5,923,600 head, 3 percent more than a year earlier, but 7 percent less than a month earlier. The average live weight of hogs slaughtered during the month was 247 pounds per head, 4 pounds heavier than June last year and 3 pounds heavier than last month. Lard rendered per 100 pounds of live weight of hogs was 12.6 pounds this June compared with 12.5 pounds in June 1963 and May 1964.

LAMB AND MUTTON OUTPUT UP 4 PERCENT FROM LAST YEAR

There were 55 million pounds of lamb and mutton produced during June, up 4 percent from a year earlier, but the same as a month earlier. The number of sheep and lambs slaughtered during the month was 1,199,600 head, 6 percent more than June 1963 and 7 percent more than May 1964. Sheep and lambs slaughtered during June averaged 94 pounds per head live weight, the same as a year earlier but 4 pounds lighter than last month.

JUNE POULTRY SLAUGHTER 10 PERCENT ABOVE A YEAR EARLIER

Production of poultry meat during June was 611 million pounds, ready-to-cook basis. This is 10 percent greater than last year and 7 percent more than May 1964.
