

LIVESTOCK SLAUGHTER

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JUNE 1978

COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in June 1978 totaled 3.08 billion pounds, down 7 percent from June 1977, according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-June total red meat output at 19.0 billion pounds was 2 percent below last year...change by individual components: beef, down 3 percent; veal, down 16; pork, virtually no change; lamb and mutton, down 14 percent. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for June 1978 included 22 weekdays and 4 Saturdays, the same as June 1977.

COMPARING JUNE 1978 WITH JUNE 1977:

BEEF PRODUCTION at 1.96 billion pounds was down 10 percent. Head kill at 3.26 million was down 10 percent while average live weight increased 3 pounds to 1026.

VEAL PRODUCTION at 47 million pounds declined 29 percent from a year ago. Calf slaughter of 318 thousand head was down 28 percent and average live weight dropped 11 pounds.

PORK PRODUCTION totaled 1.05 billion pounds from the 6.02 million head killed. Production was up 2 percent and average live weight increased 4 pounds to 244. Preliminary lard production was 81 million pounds, down 5 percent from a year earlier.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION declined 14 percent to 25 million pounds. Head kill at 457 thousand was down 20 percent while average live weight rose 7 pounds to 111.
