

LIVESTOCK SLAUGHTER

COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in January 1979 totaled 3.28 billion pounds, up 2 percent from January 1978, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for January included 23 weekdays (one a holiday) and 4 Saturdays, compared with 22 weekdays (one a holiday) and 4 Saturdays for 1978.

COMPARING JANUARY 1979 WITH JANUARY 1978:

Beef Production at 2.07 billion pounds was down slightly. Head kill at 3.30 million was down 5 percent, while average live weight increased 29 pounds to 1062.

Veal Production at 41 million pounds decreased 34 percent from a year ago. Calf slaughter of 296 thousand head was down 30 percent and average live weight declined 13 pounds to 235.

Pork Production totaled 1.15 billion pounds, up 9 percent from a year ago. The 6.70 million head killed was up 7 percent and average live weight increased 5 pounds to 241. Preliminary lard production was 83 million pounds, up 2 percent.

Lamb and Mutton Production declined 8 percent to 23 million pounds. Head kill at 402 thousand was down 8 percent, while average live weight increased 3 pounds to 114.

NOTE: The January and December 1978 figures in this release may be revised in the Annual Slaughter Report to be released March 15, 1979.
