

# LIVESTOCK SLAUGHTER

COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in June 1979 totaled 2.99 billion pounds, down 3 percent from June 1978, according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-June red meat production at 18.1 billion pounds was 5 percent below last year...change by individual components: beef, down 12 percent; veal, down 35; pork, up 10; lamb and mutton, down 5 percent. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for June included 21 weekdays and 5 Saturdays, compared with 22 weekdays and 4 Saturdays for June 1978.

## COMPARING JUNE 1979 WITH JUNE 1978:

BEEF PRODUCTION at 1.72 billion pounds was down 12 percent. Head kill at 2.71 million was down 17 percent, while average live weight increased 31 pounds to 1057.

VEAL PRODUCTION at 32 million pounds was down 32 percent. Calf slaughter at 193 thousand head was down 39 percent, while average live weight increased 26 pounds to 276.

PORK PRODUCTION totaled 1.21 billion pounds, up 16 percent. The 6.94 million head killed was up 15 percent, and average live weight increased 2 pounds to 246. Preliminary lard production was 94 million pounds, up 16 percent.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION declined 16 percent to 21 million pounds. Head kill at 385 thousand was down 16 percent, while average live weight increased 1 pound to 112.

The Release date for the July Slaughter Report has been changed from August 20, 1979 to August 23, 1979
