COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States during August 1980 totaled 3.02 billion pounds, down 9 percent from August 1979, according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-August red meat production, at 25.3 billion pounds was 4 percent above last year. The 1980 accumulated production changes by individual components were: beef, down 1 percent; veal, down 14 percent; pork, up 12 percent; lamb and mutton, up 8 percent. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for August included 21 weekdays and 5 Saturdays, compared with 23 weekdays and 4 Saturdays for August 1979.

COMPARING AUGUST 1980 WITH AUGUST 1979:

BEEF PRODUCTION at 1.78 billion pounds was down 8 percent. Head kill at 2.86 million was down 6 percent and average live weight declined 3 pounds to 1051.

VEAL PRODUCTION at 31 million pounds was down 9 percent. Calf slaughter at 208 thousand head was down 14 percent, while average live weight increased 14 pounds to 249.

PORK PRODUCTION totaled 1.19 billion pounds, down 12 percent. The 7.04 million head killed was down 12 percent, while the average live weight was unchanged at 239 pounds. Preliminary lard production was 86 million pounds, down 17 percent.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION was unchanged at 23 million pounds. Head kill at 447 thousand was up 3 percent, while average live weight declined 3 pounds to 106.
