COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States during September 1980 totaled 3.22 billion pounds, up 12 percent from September 1979, according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-September red meat production, at 28.6 billion pounds, was 5 percent above last year. The 1980 accumulated production changes by individual components were: beef, up less than 1 percent; veal, down 11 percent; pork, up 12 percent; lamb and mutton, up 8 percent. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for September included 22 weekdays (one a holiday) and 4 Saturdays, compared with 20 weekdays (one a holiday) and 5 Saturdays for September 1979.

COMPARING SEPTEMBER 1980 WITH SEPTEMBER 1979

BEEF PRODUCTION at 1.83 billion pounds was up 13 percent. Head kill at 2.92 million was up 15 percent, while average live weight declined 2 pounds to 1055.

VEAL PRODUCTION at 33 million pounds was up 6 percent. Calf slaughter at 227 thousand head was up 5 percent and average live weight increased 13 pounds to 248.

PORK PRODUCTION totaled 1.34 billion pounds, up 11 percent. The 7.91 million head killed was up 11 percent, while average live weight declined 1 pound to 239. Preliminary lard production was 99 million pounds, up 8 percent.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION increased 13 percent to 26 million pounds. Head kill at 491 thousand was up 15 percent, while average live weight declined 5 pounds to 106.
