COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in June 1981, totaled 3.11 billion pounds (1.41 million metric tons), up 1 percent from June 1980, according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-June red meat production, at 19.3 billion pounds (8.75 million metric tons), was up less than 1 percent from last year. The 1981 accumulated production changes by individual components were: beef, up 5 percent; veal, up 9 percent; pork, down 6 percent; lamb and mutton, up 3 percent. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for June included 22 weekdays and 4 Saturdays, compared with 21 weekdays and 4 Saturdays for June 1980.

COMPARING JUNE 1981 WITH JUNE 1980:

BEEF PRODUCTION at 1.86 billion pounds (842 thousand metric tons) was up 8 percent. Head kill at 2.92 million was up 8 percent, while average live weight declined 2 pounds to 1071.

VEAL PRODUCTION at 32 million pounds (14.5 thousand metric tons) was up 7 percent. Calf slaughter at 200 thousand head was up 11 percent, while average live weight declined 1 pound to 271.

PORK PRODUCTION totaled 1.20 billion pounds (545 thousand metric tons), down 8 percent. The 6.96 million head killed was down 9 percent, while average live weight was unchanged at 244 pounds. Preliminary lard production was 91 million pounds (41.3 thousand metric tons), down 7 percent.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION increased 9 percent to 24 million pounds (10.9 thousand metric tons). Head kill at 459 thousand was up 10 percent, while average live weight declined 3 pounds to 106.

FEDERALLY INSPECTED LIVESTOCK SLAUGHTER PLANTS

The number of Federally inspected slaughter plants has increased dramatically the past 10 years as individual States have elected to discontinue their inspection programs. Currently, all plants with livestock slaughtered for commercial sales in 19 States are Federally inspected. In the remaining States, commercial plants may elect either Federal or State inspection.

Slaughter plants operating under Federal inspection (FI) on January 1, 1981, totaled 1,542 or 25 percent of all known slaughter plants (including custom) while the FI count was 726 on March 1, 1970, or 10 percent of the total. The FI plants slaughtered 94 percent of the total cattle kill (excluding slaughter on farms) during 1980 compared with 87 percent in 1969; 89 percent of the calves compared with 75 percent; 96 percent of hogs compared with 90 percent; and 96 percent of the sheep and lambs compared with 94 percent.

There were 1,624 FI plants which killed one or more head of livestock during 1980 of which 48 percent killed cattle and calves, hogs, and sheep and lambs; 20 percent, cattle and calves only; 11 percent, hogs only; and 18 percent, cattle and calves, and hogs.

There were 1,021 FI plants operating during 1980 which killed an average of 20 head or more per week for at least one species. The approximate locations of these plants are posted on the maps to show distribution and concentration, by species, for large plants (200 head or more average per week) and medium size plants (20-199 head average per week). The 532 large plants are highly specialized. Seventy-seven percent of these plants killed only one species of livestock--49 percent, cattle and calves only, 26 percent, hogs only, 2 percent, sheep and lambs only.

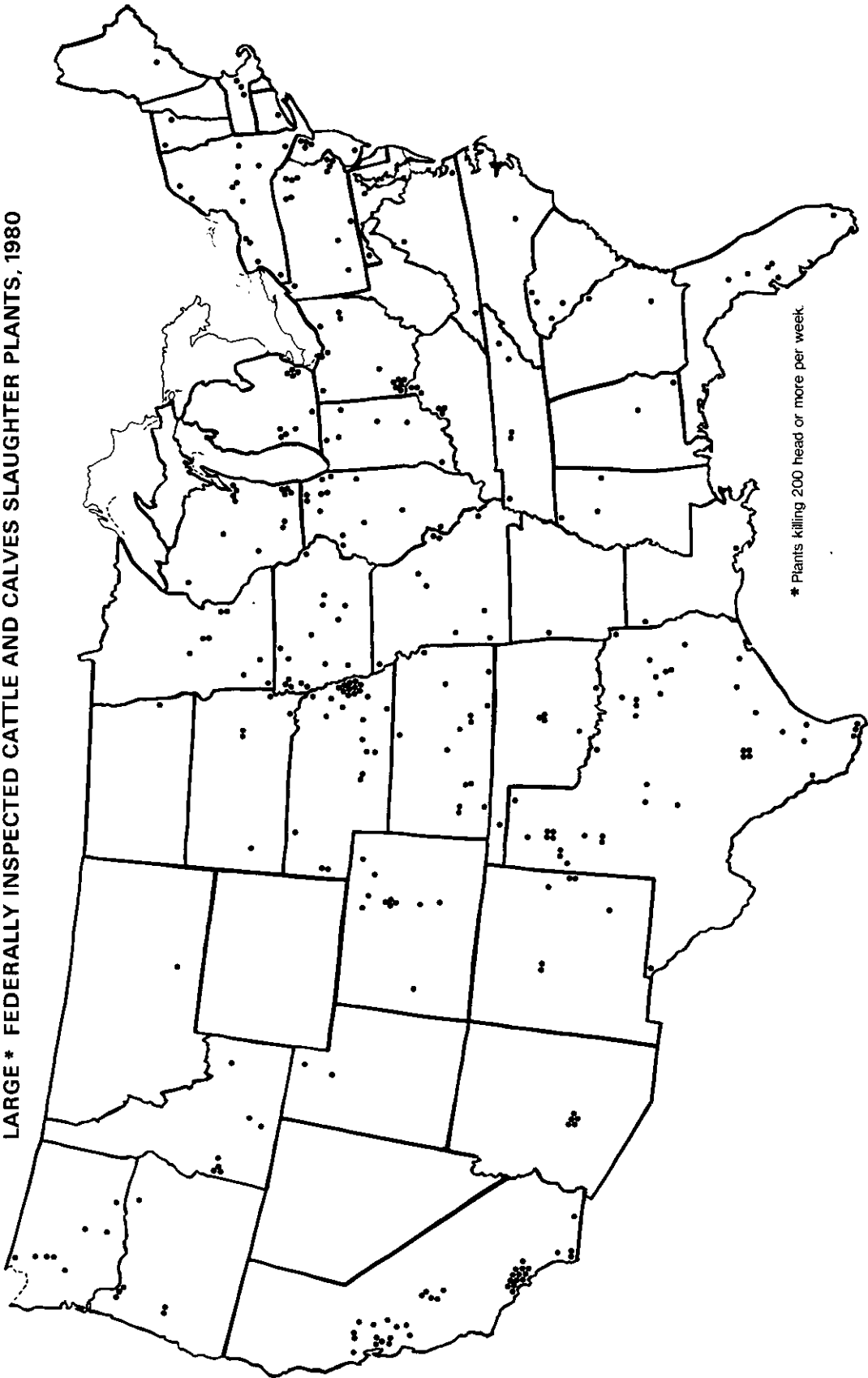

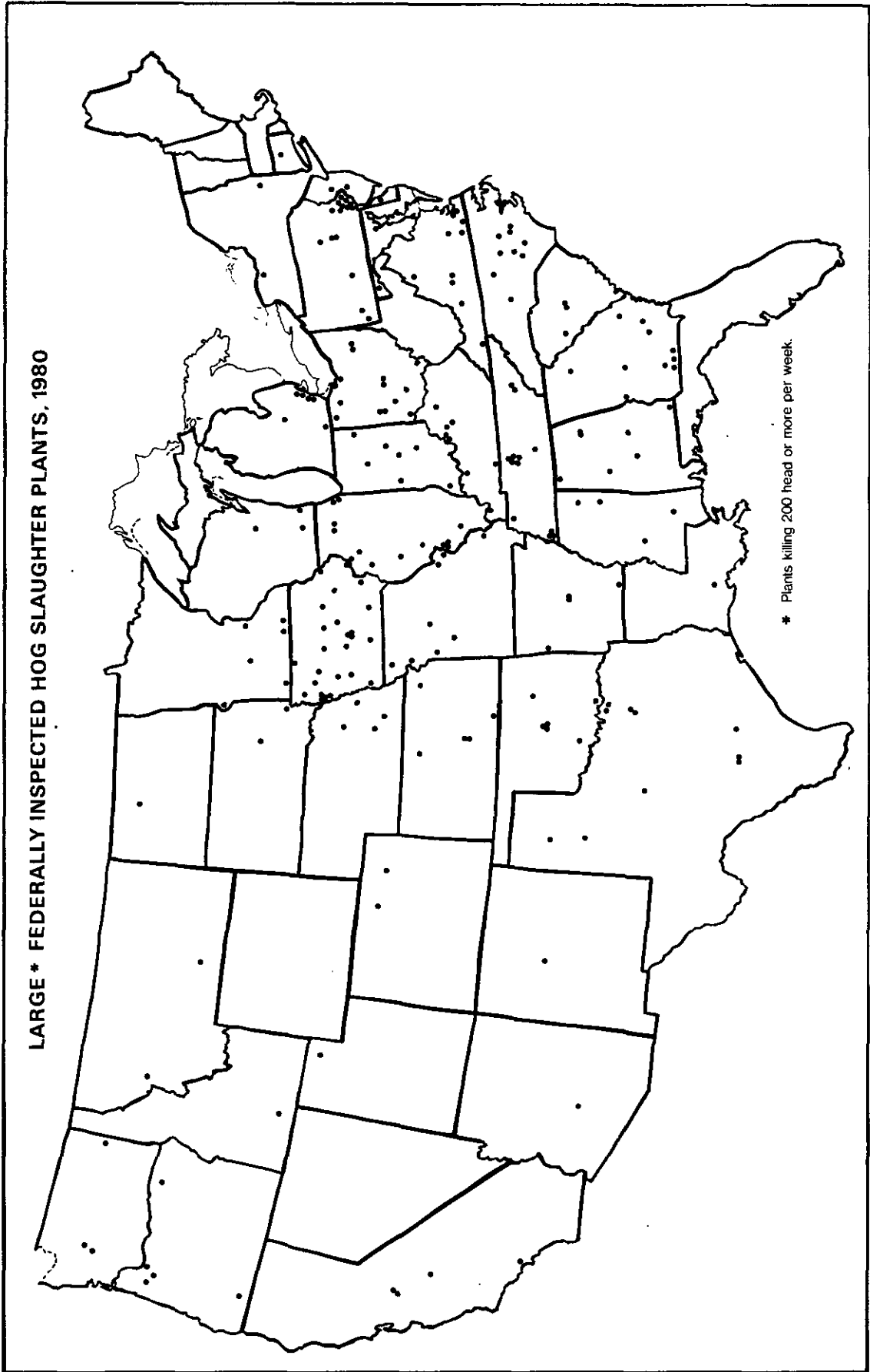

LARGE * FEDERALLY INSPECTED CATTLE AND CALVES SLAUGHTER PLANTS, 1980



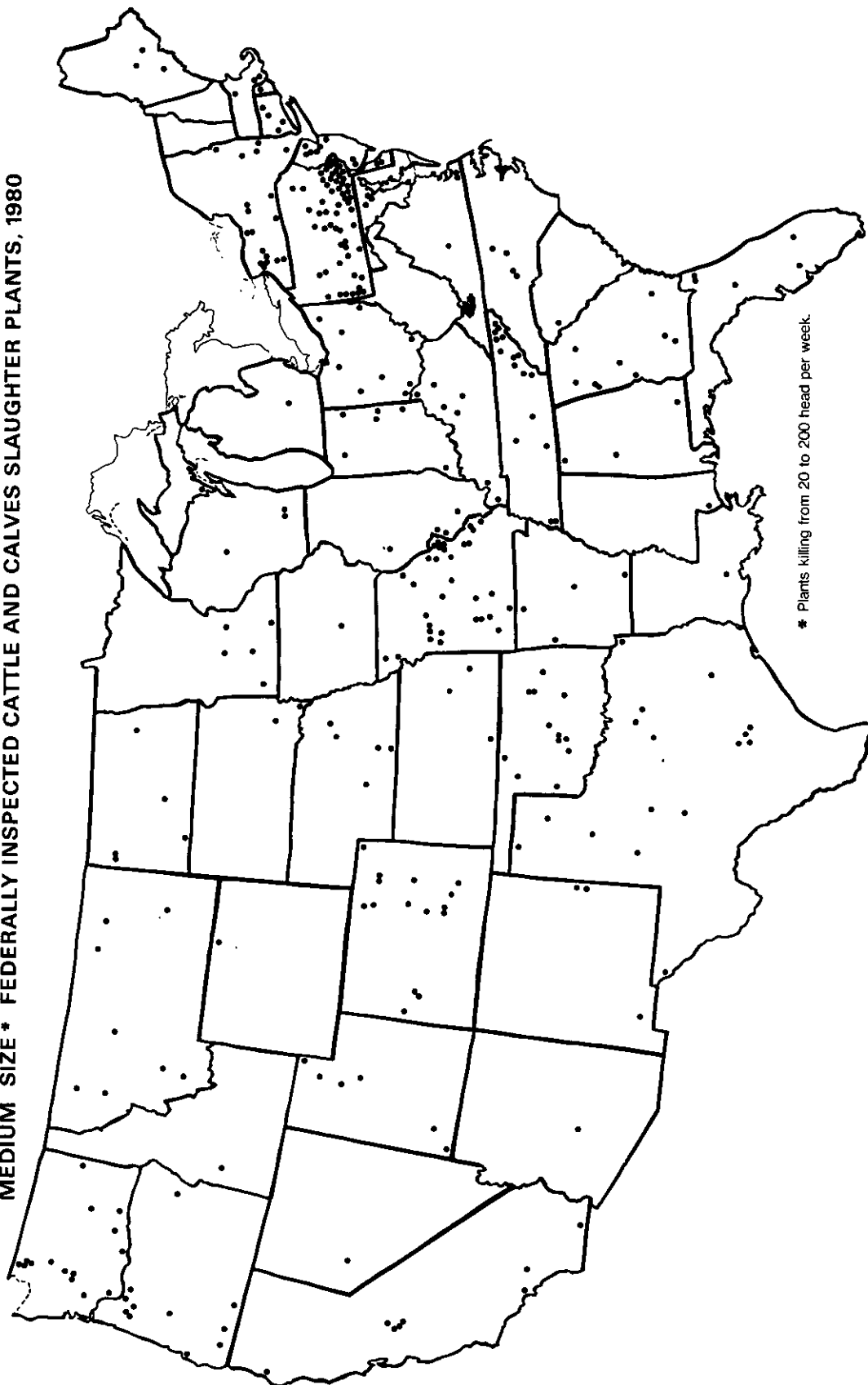

LARGE * FEDERALLY INSPECTED HOG SLAUGHTER PLANTS, 1980



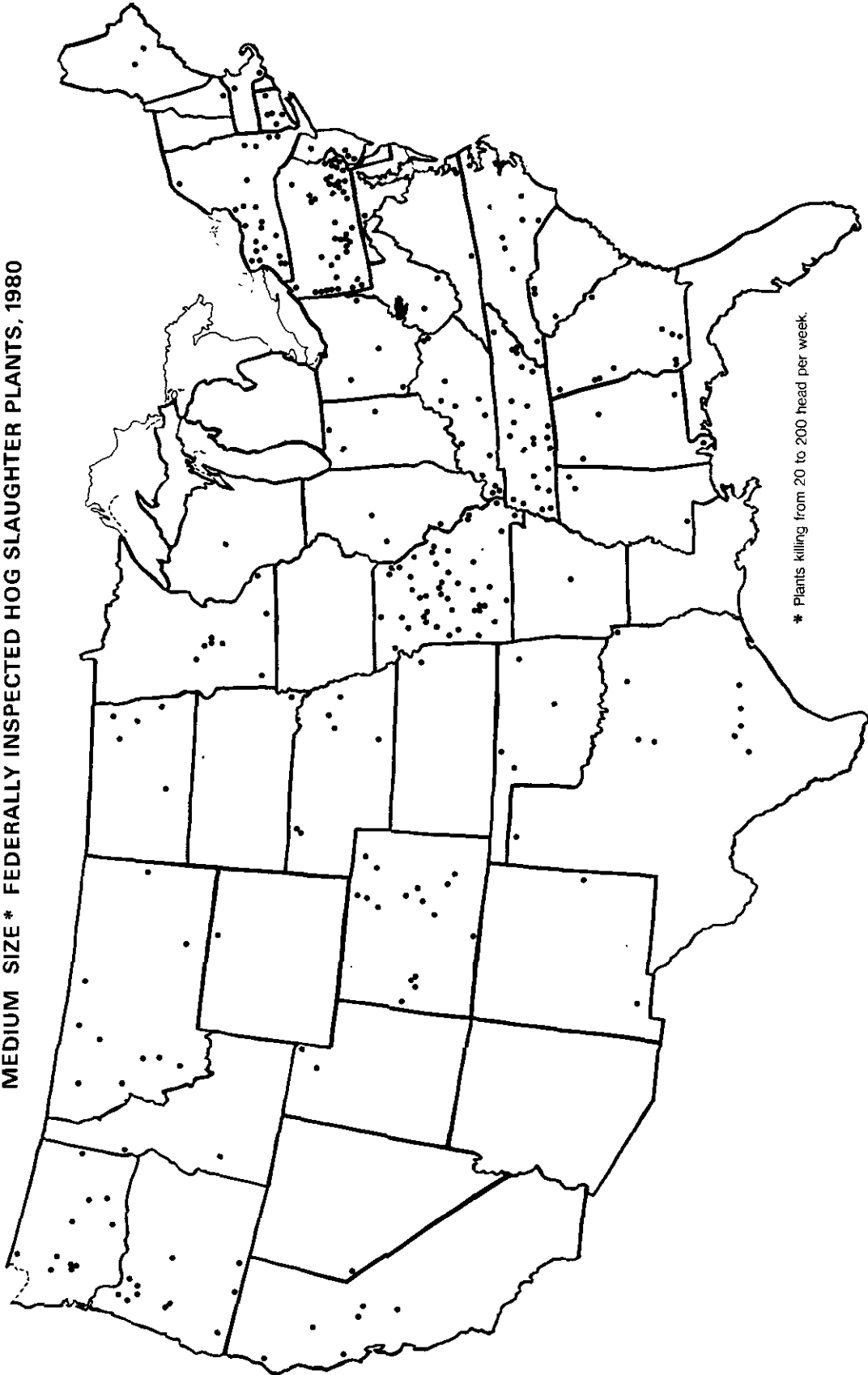

MEDIUM SIZE * FEDERALLY INSPECTED CATTLE AND CALVES SLAUGHTER PLANTS, 1980



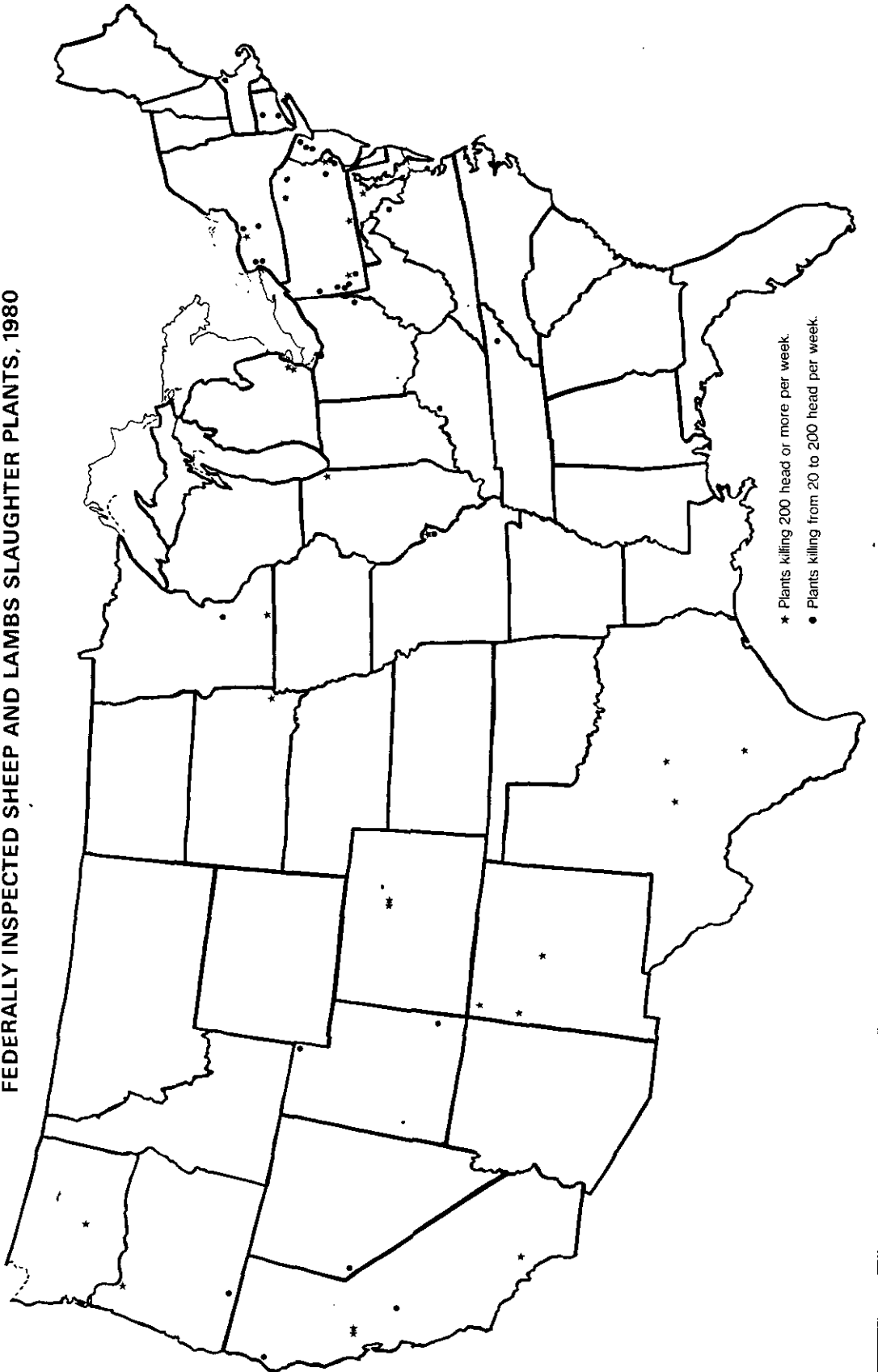

MEDIUM SIZE * FEDERALLY INSPECTED HOG SLAUGHTER PLANTS, 1980

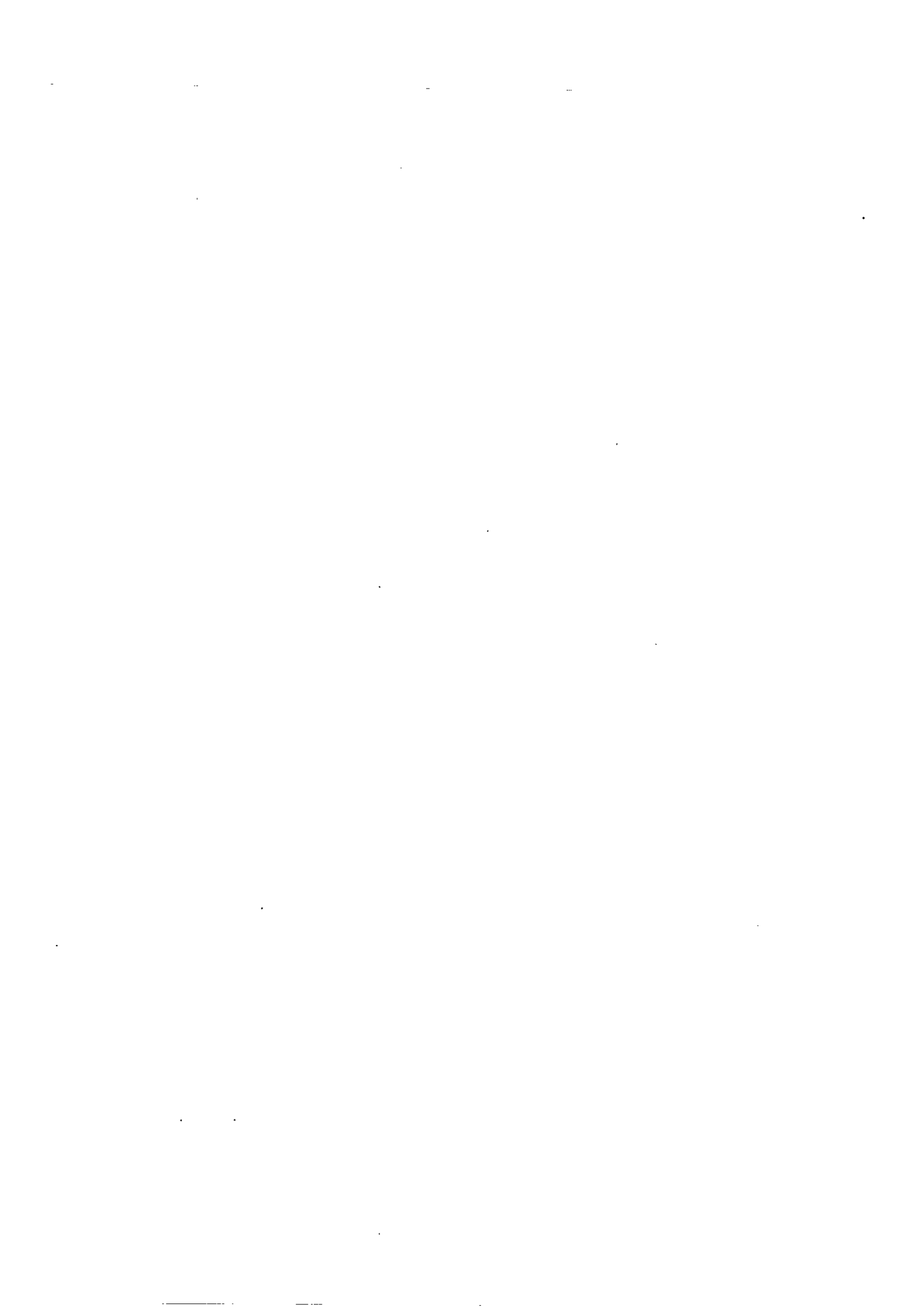
