COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in July 1981 totaled 3.04 billion pounds (1.38 million metric tons), down 1 percent from July 1980, according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-July red meat production, at 22.3 billion pounds (10.1 million metric tons), was essentially unchanged from last year. The 1981 accumulated production changes by individual components were: beef, up 4 percent; veal, up 9 percent; pork, down 6 percent; lamb and mutton, up 3 percent. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for July included 23 weekdays (one a holiday) and 4 Saturdays, the same as July 1980.

COMPARING JULY 1981 WITH JULY 1980:

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.82 billion pounds (825 thousand metric tons), was up 2 percent. Head kill, at 2.92 million was up 3 percent, while average live weight declined 5 pounds to 1054.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 34 million pounds (15.4 thousand metric tons), was up 10 percent. Calf slaughter, at 228 thousand head, was up 8 percent and average live weight increased 5 pounds to 252.

PORK PRODUCTION totaled 1.16 billion pounds (527 thousand metric tons), down 6 percent. The 6.81 million head killed was down 6 percent, while the average live weight was unchanged at 241 pounds. Preliminary lard production was 89 million pounds (40.4 thousand metric tons), down 6 percent.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION increased 4 percent to 24 million pounds (10.9 thousand metric tons). Head kill, at 460 thousand head was up 4 percent, while average live weight was unchanged at 106 pounds.
