COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States during November 1981 totaled 3.18 billion pounds (1.44 million metric tons), up 3 percent from November 1980, according to the Crop Reporting Board. *January-November red meat production at 35.2 billion pounds (16.0 million metric tons), was virtually the same as the corresponding period last year. The 1981 accumulated production changes from the 1980 period by individual components were: beef, up 3 percent; veal, up 9 percent; pork, down 5 percent; lamb and mutton, up 6 percent. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.*

Kill days for November included 21 weekdays (2 were holidays) and 4 Saturdays compared with 20 weekdays (2 were holidays) and 5 Saturdays a year ago.

COMPARING NOVEMBER 1981 WITH NOVEMBER 1980

BEEF PRODUCTION at 1.80 billion pounds (817 thousand metric tons), was up 6 percent. Head kill at 2.85 million was up 5 percent, and the average live weight of 1073 pounds was up 2 pounds.

VEAL PRODUCTION at 35 million pounds (15.9 thousand metric tons), was up 13 percent. Calf slaughter at 247 thousand head was up 15 percent, while the average live weight of 241 pounds was down 6 pounds.

PORK PRODUCTION totaled 1.32 billion pounds (599 thousand metric tons), down 1 percent. The 7.60 million head killed was down 1 percent, while the average live weight was unchanged at 246 pounds. Preliminary lard production was 99 million pounds (44.9 thousand metric tons), up 3 percent.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION increased 13 percent to 27 million pounds (12.3 thousand metric tons). Head kill at 491 thousand was up 14 percent, while the average live weight declined 3 pounds to 110.
