

LIVESTOCK SLAUGHTER



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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in February 1982 totaled 2.89 billion pounds (1.31 million metric tons), down 4 percent from February 1981, according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-February red meat production, at 6.05 billion pounds (2.74 million metric tons), was down 6 percent from last year. The 1982 accumulated production changes by individual components were: beef, down 2 percent; veal, up 3 percent; pork, down 11 percent; lamb and mutton, up 4 percent. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for February included 20 weekdays (one a holiday) and 4 Saturdays, the same as February 1981.

COMPARING FEBRUARY 1982 WITH FEBRUARY 1981:

BEEF PRODUCTION at 1.72 billion pounds (779 thousand metric tons), was nearly the same as a year ago. Head kill at 2.74 million was up 3 percent, while average live weight decreased 21 pounds to 1072.

VEAL PRODUCTION at 32 million pounds (14.5 thousand metric tons), was up 7 percent. Calf slaughter at 231 thousand head was up 10 percent, while average live weight decreased 9 pounds to 234.

PORK PRODUCTION totaled 1.12 billion pounds (506 thousand metric tons), down 10 percent. The 6.59 million head killed was down 8 percent, while average live weight decreased 3 pounds to 239. Preliminary lard production was 77 million pounds (34.9 thousand metric tons), down 11 percent.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION increased 8 percent to 28 million pounds (12.7 thousand metric tons). Head kill, at 499 thousand, was up 14 percent. Average live weight decreased 3 pounds to 113.
