Statistical Reporting
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April-June 1982

COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States during April through June 1982 totaled 9.10 billion pounds (4.13 million metric tons), down 4 percent from the April through June 1981 quarter, according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-June red meat production, at 18.4 billion pounds (8.36 million metric tons), declined 4 percent from the corresponding period last year. The 1982 accumulated production percent changes from last year by individual components were: beef, down 2; veal, up 5; pork, down 9; lamb and mutton, up 9. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for April through June included 65 weekdays (one a holiday) and 13 Saturdays, the same as April through June 1981.

COMPARING APRIL-JUNE 1982 WITH APRIL-JUNE 1981:

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 5.36 billion pounds (2.43 million metric tons), was down 1 percent. Head kill, at 8.64 million, was up 2 percent while average live weight declined 21 pounds to 1058.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 99 million pounds (44.9 thousand metric tons), increased 4 percent. Calf slaughter, at 674 thousand head, was up 13 percent while live weight declined 17 pounds to 248.

PORK PRODUCTION totaled 3.55 billion pounds (1.61 million metric tons), down 9 percent. The 20.7 million head killed was down 8 percent and average live weight, at 242 pounds, declined 1 pound. Preliminary lard production was 257 million pounds (117 thousand metric tons), down 12 percent.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION increased 10 percent to 85 million pounds (38.6 thousand metric tons). Head kill, at 1.54 million, was up 7 percent while average live weight increased 3 pounds to 111.

*** IMPORTANT NOTICE ***

This is the first quarterly publication of Livestock Slaughter. Prior to April 1982 this report had been issued on a monthly basis. The change to quarterly summarization of slaughter data resulted in slight changes in previously released production levels based on monthly summarization. These changes affected production levels by generally less than one-tenth of one percent at the U.S. level.
