July-September 1982

COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States during July through September 1982 totaled 9.16 billion pounds (4.16 million metric tons), down 2 percent from the July through September 1981 quarter, according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-September red meat production, at 27.6 billion pounds (12.5 million metric tons), declined 4 percent from the corresponding period last year. The 1982 accumulated production percent changes from last year by individual components were: beef, virtually unchanged; veal, up 4; pork, down 9; lamb and mutton, up 10. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for July through September included 66 weekdays (two holidays) and 13 Saturdays, the same as July through September 1981.

COMPARING JULY-SEPTEMBER 1982 WITH JULY-SEPTEMBER 1981:

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 5.73 billion pounds (2.60 million metric tons), was up 3 percent. Head kill, at 9.21 million, was up 4 percent while average live weight declined 2 pounds to 1053.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 107 million pounds (48.5 thousand metric tons), increased 2 percent. Calf slaughter at 770 thousand head, was up 8 percent while average live weight declined 14 pounds to 234.

PORK PRODUCTION, totaled 3.24 billion pounds (1.47 million metric tons), down 10 percent. The 18.9 million head killed was down 11 percent, however, the average live weight, increased by 1 pound to 241. Preliminary lard production was 234 million pounds (106 thousand metric tons), down 14 percent.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, increased 11 percent to 88 million pounds (39.9 thousand metric tons). Head kill, at 1.63 million, was up 7 percent while average live weight increased 3 pounds to 109.
