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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States during October through December 1982 totaled 9.66 billion pounds (4.38 million metric tons), down 4 percent from the October-December 1981 quarter, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Red meat production during 1982, at 37.3 billion pounds (16.9 million metric tons), declined 4 percent from 1981. The 1982 production percent change from 1981 by individual components were: beef, up 1 percent; veal, up 2 percent; pork, down 10 percent; lamb and mutton, up 9 percent. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for October through December included 66 weekdays (5 holidays) and 13 Saturdays, compared with 66 weekdays (4 holidays) and 13 Saturdays during the October-December 1981 quarter.

COMPARING OCTOBER-DECEMBER 1982 WITH OCTOBER-DECEMBER 1981:

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 5.82 billion pounds (2.64 million metric tons), was up 2 percent. Head kill, at 9.31 million, was up 3 percent while average live weight declined 3 pounds to 1070.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 110 million pounds (49.9 thousand metric tons), declined 4 percent. Calf slaughter at 806 thousand head, was up fractionally while average live weight declined 13 pounds to 230.

PORK PRODUCTION totaled 3.64 billion pounds (1.65 million metric tons), down 12 percent. The 20.8 million head killed was down 13 percent, however, the average live weight, increased by 1 pound to 246. Preliminary lard production was 261 million pounds (118 thousand metric tons), down 15 percent.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION increased 7 percent to 93 million pounds (42.2 thousand metric tons). Head kill, at 1.68 million, was up 5 percent while average live weight increased 1 pound to 111.
