COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States during January 1983 totaled 3.15 billion pounds (1.43 million metric tons), according to the Crop Reporting Board. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for January 1983 included 21 weekdays and 5 Saturdays (one a holiday).

BEEF PRODUCTION totaled 1.93 billion pounds (874 thousand metric tons). Total head killed was 3.06 million and live weight averaged 1077 pounds per head.

VEAL PRODUCTION was 34 million pounds (15.4 thousand metric tons). Calf slaughter of 244 thousand head averaged 237 pounds live weight.

PORK PRODUCTION during the month totaled 1.16 billion pounds (526 thousand metric tons). Hog kill totaled 6.67 million head. Average live weight for the month was 244 pounds.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION was 30 million pounds (13.6 thousand metric tons). Head kill of 522 thousand averaged 113 pounds live weight.
