

# LIVESTOCK SLAUGHTER



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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States during February 1983 totaled 2.79 billion pounds (1.26 million metric tons), according to the Crop Reporting Board. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill day for February 1983 included 20 weekdays (one a holiday) and 4 Saturdays.

BEEF PRODUCTION totaled 1.71 billion pounds (774 thousand metric tons). Total head killed was 2.69 million and live weight averaged 1084 pounds per head.

VEAL PRODUCTION was 32 million pounds (14.5 thousand metric tons). Calf slaughter of 224 thousand head averaged 239 pounds live weight.

PORK PRODUCTION during the month totaled 1.02 billion pounds (463 thousand metric tons). Hog kill totaled 5.96 million head. Average live weight for the month was 240 pounds.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION was 27 million pounds (12.3 thousand metric tons). Head kill of 468 thousand averaged 115 pounds live weight.
