COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION in the United States for April 1983 totaled 3.04 billion pounds (1.38 million metric tons), according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-April accumulated red meat production totaled 12.2 billion pounds (5.55 million metric tons). Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for April included 21 weekdays and 5 Saturdays.

BEEF PRODUCTION during April totaled 1.73 billion pounds (783 thousand metric tons). Total head killed was 2.76 million and live weight averaged 1068 pounds per head.

VEAL PRODUCTION was 32 million pounds (14.5 thousand metric tons). Calf slaughter of 224 thousand head averaged 244 pounds live weight.

PORK PRODUCTION totaled 1.25 billion pounds (567 thousand metric tons). Hog kill totaled 7.22 million head. Average live weight for the month was 243 pounds.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION was 30 million pounds (13.6 thousand metric tons). Head kill of 523 thousand averaged 115 pounds live weight.
