COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION in the United States for May 1983 totaled 3.15 billion pounds (1.43 million metric tons), according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-May accumulated red meat production totaled 15.4 billion pounds (6.98 million metric tons). Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for May included 22 weekdays (1 Holiday) and 4 Saturdays.

BEEF PRODUCTION during May totaled 1.86 billion pounds (843 thousand metric tons). Total head killed was 2.96 million and live weight averaged 1065 pounds per head.

VEAL PRODUCTION was 32 million pounds (14.5 thousand metric tons). Calf slaughter of 214 thousand head averaged 254 pounds live weight.

PORK PRODUCTION totaled 1.23 billion pounds (557 thousand metric tons). Hog kill totaled 7.03 million head. Average live weight for the month was 245 pounds.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION was 30 million pounds (13.6 thousand metric tons). Head kill of 527 thousand averaged 113 pounds live weight.
