

# LIVESTOCK SLAUGHTER

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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION in the United States for June 1983 totaled 3.28 billion pounds (1.49 million metric tons), according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-June red meat production, at 18.7 billion pounds (8.47 million metric tons), was up 1 percent from the comparable period in 1982. The 1983 January-June red meat production changes from a year earlier by individual components were: beef, up 2 percent; veal, down 2 percent; pork, down slightly; lamb and mutton, up 4 percent. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for June included 22 weekdays and 4 Saturdays, the same as June 1982.

BEEF PRODUCTION for June totaled 1.97 billion pounds (891 thousand metric tons). Total head killed was 3.13 million and live weight averaged 1060 pounds per head.

VEAL PRODUCTION was 34 million pounds (15.4 thousand metric tons). Calf slaughter of 232 thousand head averaged 245 pounds live weight.

PORK PRODUCTION during the month totaled 1.25 billion pounds (567 thousand metric tons). Hog kill totaled 7.15 million head. Average live weight for the month was 246 pounds.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION was 29 million pounds (13.2 thousand metric tons). Sheep and lamb kill totaled 525 thousand head averaging 112 pounds live weight.
