COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION in the United States for July 1983 totaled 2.99 billion pounds (1.35 million metric tons), according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-July accumulated red meat production totaled 21.7 billion pounds (9.82 million metric tons). Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for July included 21 weekdays (1 Holiday) and 5 Saturdays.

BEEF PRODUCTION during July totaled 1.81 billion pounds (819 thousand metric tons). Total head killed was 2.87 million and live weight averaged 1067 pounds per head.

VEAL PRODUCTION was 33 million pounds (15.0 thousand metric tons). Calf slaughter of 236 thousand head averaged 240 pounds live weight.

PORK PRODUCTION totaled 1.12 billion pounds (508 thousand metric tons). Hog kill totaled 6.47 million head, yielding an average live weight of 244 pounds.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION was 28 million pounds (12.7 thousand metric tons). Head kill of 514 thousand averaged 110 pounds live weight.
