COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION in the United States for August 1983 totaled 3.44 billion pounds (1.56 million metric tons), according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-August accumulated red meat production totaled 25.1 billion pounds (11.4 million metric tons). Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for August included 23 weekdays and 4 Saturdays.

BEEF PRODUCTION during August totaled 2.12 billion pounds (960 thousand metric tons). Total head killed was 3.37 million and live weight averaged 1064 pounds per head.

VEAL PRODUCTION was 39 million pounds (17.7 thousand metric tons). Calf slaughter of 286 thousand head averaged 230 pounds live weight.

PORK PRODUCTION totaled 1.25 billion pounds (567 thousand metric tons). Hog kill totaled 7.32 million head, with an average live weight of 241 pounds.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION was 33 million pounds (15.0 thousand metric tons). Head kill of 607 thousand averaged 110 pounds live weight.
