COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION in the United States for October 1983 totaled 3.53 billion pounds (1.60 million metric tons), according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-October accumulated red meat production totaled 32.1 billion pounds (14.5 million metric tons). Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for October included 21 weekdays (1 Holiday) and 5 Saturdays.

BEEF PRODUCTION for October totaled 2.07 billion pounds (937 thousand metric tons). Total head killed was 3.28 million and live weight averaged 1070 pounds.

VEAL PRODUCTION was 41 million pounds (18.6 thousand metric tons). Calf slaughter of 290 thousand head averaged 239 pounds live weight.

PORK PRODUCTION during the month totaled 1.39 billion pounds (630 thousand metric tons). Hog kill totaled 8.09 million head, with an average live weight of 243 pounds.

LAMB AND MUTTON was 32 million pounds (14.5 thousand metric tons). Head kill of 600 thousand averaged 109 pounds live weight.
