COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION in the United States for November 1983 totaled 3.47 billion pounds (1.58 million metric tons), according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-November accumulated red meat production totaled 35.5 billion pounds (16.1 million metric tons). Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for November included 22 weekdays (2 Holiday) and 4 Saturdays.

BEEF PRODUCTION for November totaled 1.94 billion pounds (879 thousand metric tons). Total head killed was 3.08 million and live weight averaged 1077 pounds.

VEAL PRODUCTION was 39 million pounds (17.7 thousand metric tons). Calf slaughter of 294 thousand head averaged 229 pounds live weight.

PORK PRODUCTION during the month totaled 1.47 billion pounds (666 thousand metric tons). Hog kill totaled 8.43 million head, with an average live weight of 246 pounds.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION was 29 million pounds (13.2 thousand metric tons). Head kill of 528 thousand averaged 111 pounds live weight.
