COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION in the United States for January 1984 totaled 3.22 billion pounds (1.46 million metric tons), up 2 percent from January 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for January included 22 weekdays (1 holiday) and 4 Saturdays.

COMPARING JANUARY 1984 WITH JANUARY 1983

BEEF PRODUCTION at 1.91 billion pounds (868 thousand metric tons), was down 1 percent. Total head killed was 3.11 million, up 1 percent, and live weight averaged 1066 pounds, a decline of 11 pounds.

VEAL PRODUCTION was 39 million pounds (17.7 thousand metric tons), an increase of 15 percent. Calf slaughter of 277 thousand head was up 14 percent with average live weight increasing 3 pounds to 240.

PORK PRODUCTION totaled 1.23 billion pounds (560 thousand metric tons), an increase of 6 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.19 million head, an increase of 8 percent, with the average live weight declining 2 pounds to 242 pounds.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION was 31 million pounds (14.1 thousand metric tons), an increase of 3 percent. The monthly head kill of 553 thousand was up 6 percent while the average live weight remained unchanged at 113 pounds.
