COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in June 1984 totaled 3.20 billion pounds (1.45 million metric tons), down 3 percent from June 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-June red meat production, at 19.4 billion pounds (8.78 million metric tons), is up 3 percent from last year. The 1984 accumulated production percent changes by individual components were: beef, up 4 percent; veal, up 13 percent; pork, up 2 percent; lamb and mutton, up 5 percent. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for June 1984 included 21 weekdays and 5 Saturdays.

## COMPARING JUNE 1984 WITH JUNE 1983

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.98 billion pounds (900 thousand metric tons), was up 1 percent. Head kill was 3.19 million, up 2 percent, however, the average live weight declined 2 pounds to 1059.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 38 million pounds (17.2 thousand metric tons), was up 12 percent. Calf slaughter of 242 thousand head was up 4 percent and average live weight increased 19 pounds to 264.

PORK PRODUCTION, totaled 1.16 billion pounds (524 thousand metric tons), down 9 percent. The 6.59 million head killed was down 9 percent, while the average live weight increased 1 pound to 247.

LAMB AND MUTTON, dropped 7 percent to 27 million pounds (12.3 thousand metric tons). Slaughter totaled 517 thousand head, down 2 percent. The average live weight declined 5 pounds to 107.
