COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in July 1984 totaled 3.04 billion pounds (1.38 million metric tons), up 1 percent from July 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-July red meat production, at 22.4 billion pounds (10.2 million metric tons), is up 3 percent from last year. The 1984 accumulated production percent changes by individual components were: beef, up 4 percent; veal, up 14 percent; pork, up 1 percent; lamb and mutton, up 4 percent. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for July 1984 included 22 weekdays (one a holiday) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING JULY 1984 WITH JULY 1983

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.94 billion pounds (878 thousand metric tons), was up 7 percent. Head kill was 3.13 million, up 9 percent; however, the average live weight declined 12 pounds to 1055.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 39 million pounds (17.7 thousand metric tons), was up 18 percent. Calf slaughter of 275 thousand head was up 16 percent and average live weight remained unchanged at 240.

PORK PRODUCTION, totaled 1.04 billion pounds (472 thousand metric tons), down 8 percent. The 6.00 million head killed was down 9 percent, while the average live weight remained unchanged at 244.

LAMB AND MUTTON, at 28 million pounds (12.7 thousand metric tons), remained unchanged. Slaughter totaled 529 thousand head, up 3 percent, but the average live weight declined 3 pounds to 107.
