COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in August 1984 totaled 3.36 billion pounds (1.52 million metric tons), down 2 percent from August 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-August red meat production, at 25.8 billion pounds (11.7 million metric tons), is up 2 percent from last year. The 1984 accumulated production percent changes by individual components were: beef, up 4 percent; veal, up 14 percent; pork, unchanged; lamb and mutton up 2 percent. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for August 1984 included 23 weekdays and four Saturdays.

## COMPARING AUGUST 1984 WITH AUGUST 1983

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.11 billion pounds (958 thousand metric tons), was down slightly. Head kill was 3.39 million, up 1 percent; however, the average live weight declined 4 pounds to 1060.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 44 million pounds (20.0 thousand metric tons), was up 13 percent. Calf slaughter of 314 thousand head was up 10 percent and average live weight increased 3 pounds to 233.

PORK PRODUCTION, totaled 1.18 million pounds (533 thousand metric tons), down 6 percent. The 6.84 million head killed was down 6 percent, however, the average live weight increased 1 pound to 242.

LAMB AND MUTTON, at 31 million pounds (14.1 thousand metric tons), declined 6 percent. Slaughter totaled 583 thousand head, down 4 percent, and the average live weight declined 2 pounds to 108 pounds.
