COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in October 1984 totaled 3.67 billion pounds (1.66 million metric tons), up 4 percent from October 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-October red meat production, at 32.5 billion pounds (14.8 million metric tons), was up 1 percent from last year. The 1984 accumulated production percent changes by individual components were: Beef, up 3 percent; veal, up 13 percent; pork, down 1 percent; lamb and mutton, up 1 percent. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for October 1984 included 23 weekdays (one a holiday) and four Saturdays. Kill days for October 1983 consisted of 21 weekdays (one a holiday) and five Saturdays.

COMPARING OCTOBER 1984 WITH OCTOBER 1983

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.18 billion pounds (989 thousand metric tons), was up 6 percent. Head kill was 3.48 million, up 6 percent, and average live weight increased 2 pounds to 1072.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 45 million pounds (20.4 thousand metric tons), was up 10 percent. Calf slaughter of 308 thousand head was up 6 percent, and average live weight increased 9 pounds to 248.

PORK PRODUCTION, totaled 1.41 billion pounds (640 thousand metric tons), up 2 percent. The 8.15 million head killed was up 1 percent, and average live weight increased 1 pound to 244.

LAMB AND MUTTON, at 33 million pounds (15.0 thousand metric tons), was up 3 percent. Slaughter totaled 608 thousand head, up 1 percent, and average live weight increased 1 pound to 110.
