COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in November 1984 totaled 3.32 billion pounds (1.51 million metric tons), down 4 percent from November 1983, according to the Crop Reporting Board. January-November red meat production, at 35.9 billion pounds (16.3 million metric tons), up 1 percent from last year. The 1984 accumulated production percentage changes by individual components were: Beef, up 2 percent; veal, up 12 percent; pork, down 2 percent; lamb and mutton, up 1 percent. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for November 1984 included 22 weekdays (two were holidays) and four Saturdays. Kill days for November 1983 consisted of 22 weekdays (two were holidays) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING NOVEMBER 1984 WITH NOVEMBER 1983

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.92 billion pounds (872 thousand metric tons), was down 1 percent. Head kill was 3.08 million, up fractionally; however, the average live weight declined 5 pounds to 1072.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 43 million pounds (19.5 thousand metric tons), was up 10 percent. Calf slaughter of 298 thousand head was up 1 percent, and the average live weight increased 13 pounds to 242.

PORK PRODUCTION, totaled 1.33 billion pounds (602 thousand metric tons), down 10 percent. The 7.60 million head killed declined 10 percent, but the average live weight, at 246 pounds was unchanged.

LAMB AND MUTTON, at 30 million pounds (13.6 thousand metric tons), was up 3 percent. Slaughter totaled 540 thousand head, up 2 percent, and average live weight increased 2 pounds to 113.
