COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in January 1985 totaled 3.42 billion pounds (1.55 million metric tons), up 6 percent from January 1984, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for January 1985 included 23 weekdays (one a holiday) and four Saturdays. Kill days for January 1984 consisted of 22 weekdays (one a holiday) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING JANUARY 1985 WITH JANUARY 1984

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.07 billion pounds (937 thousand metric tons), was up 8 percent. Head kills was 3.28 million, up 5 percent, and the average live weight increased 15 pounds to 1081.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 43 million pounds (19.5 thousand metric tons), was up 10 percent. Calf slaughter of 288 thousand head was up 4 percent and the average live weight increased 7 pounds to 247.

PORK PRODUCTION, totaled 1.28 billion pounds (581 thousand metric tons), up 4 percent. Hog kill at 7.34 million head increased 2 percent and the average live weight increased 3 pounds to 245.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 32 million pounds (14.5 thousand metric tons), was up 3 percent. Slaughter totaled 557 thousand head, up 1 percent, and the average live weight increased 2 pounds to 115.
