COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in July 1985 totaled 3.28 billion pounds (1.49 million metric tons), up 8 percent from July 1984, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is the record high July red meat production level. The previous July record high totaled 3.07 billion pounds (1.39 million metric tons) in 1980. January-July red meat production, at 22.7 billion pounds (10.3 million metric tons), was up 1 percent from last year. The 1985 accumulated production changes by individual components were: beef, up 2 percent; veal, up 5 percent; pork, up 1 percent; lamb and mutton, down 6 percent.

Kill days for July 1985 included 23 weekdays (one a holiday) and four Saturdays, one weekday more than in July 1984.

## COMPARING JULY 1985 WITH JULY 1984

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.06 billion pounds (934 thousand metric tons), was up 6 percent. Cattle kill totaled 3.14 million head, up fractionally. The average live weight increased 45 pounds to 1100.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 43 million pounds (19.5 thousand metric tons), was up 8 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 291 thousand head, up 4 percent. Live weight averaged 250 pounds, 9 pounds heavier than last year.

PORK PRODUCTION totaled 1.15 billion pounds (520 thousand metric tons), up 10 percent. Hog kill totaled 6.60 million head, up 10 percent. Average live weight was unchanged at 244 pounds.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 28 million pounds (12.7 thousand metric tons), was unchanged from last year. Slaughter totaled 503 thousand head, down 5 percent. Live weight averaged 112 pounds, 5 pounds heavier than a year earlier.
