COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in January 1986 totaled 3.48 billion pounds (1.58 million metric tons), up 2 percent from January 1985, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for January 1986 included 23 weekdays (two were holidays) and four Saturdays. Kill days for January 1985 consisted of 23 weekdays (one a holiday) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING JANUARY 1986 WITH JANUARY 1985

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.14 billion pounds (970 thousand metric tons), was up 4 percent. Head kill was 3.33 million, up 2 percent, and the average live weight increased 20 pounds to 1100.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 46 million pounds (20.9 thousand metric tons), was up 10 percent. Calf slaughter of 307 thousand head was up 7 percent and the average live weight increased 7 pounds to 249.

PORK PRODUCTION, totaled 1.27 billion pounds (574 thousand metric tons), down 1 percent. Hog kill at 7.19 million head declined 2 percent, however, the average live weight increased 1 pound to 246.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 31 million pounds (14.1 thousand metric tons), was down 3 percent. Slaughter totaled 518 thousand head, down 7 percent, and the average live weight increased 3 pounds to 118.
