COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in June 1986 totaled 3.16 billion pounds (1.43 million metric tons), up 2 percent from June 1985, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-June red meat production, at 19.6 billion pounds (8.88 million metric tons), was up 1 percent from last year. The percentage changes in accumulated production by individual components were: beef, up 3; veal, up 8; pork, down 3; lamb and mutton, down 5. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for June 1986 included 21 weekdays and four Saturdays. Kill days for June 1985 consisted of 20 weekdays and five Saturdays.

COMPARING JUNE 1986 WITH JUNE 1985

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.03 billion pounds (919 thousand metric tons), was up 7 percent. Head kill totaled 3.12 million, up 8 percent, however, the average live weight decreased 10 pounds to 1094.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 41 million pounds (18.6 thousand metric tons), was up 11 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 257 thousand head, up 9 percent. The average live weight decreased 5 pounds to 262.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.07 billion pounds (483 thousand metric tons), was down 5 percent from the previous year. Hog kill totaled 6.08 million head, a decline of 5 percent. The average live weight declined 2 pounds to 245.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 24 million pounds (10.9 thousand metric tons), was unchanged. Slaughter totaled 419 thousand head, down 4 percent. The average live weight increased by 2 pounds to 115.
