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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in August 1986 totaled 3.18 billion pounds (1.44 million metric tons), down 6 percent from August 1985, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-August red meat production, at 26.0 billion pounds (11.8 million metric tons), was down fractionally from a year earlier. The percentage changes in accumulated production by individual components were: beef, up 3; veal, up 7; pork, down 5; lamb and mutton, down 6. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill day for August 1986 consisted of 21 weekdays and five Saturdays. Kill days for August 1985 included 22 weekdays and five Saturdays.

## COMPARING AUGUST 1986 WITH AUGUST 1985

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.08 billion pounds (942 thousand metric tons), was down 2 percent. Head kill totaled 3.20 million, down fractionally. The average live weight decreased 11 pounds to 1091.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 42 million pounds (19.1 thousand metric tons), was up 2 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 279 thousand head, down 4 percent; However, the average live weight increased 10 pounds to 249.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.04 billion pounds (470 thousand metric tons), was down 14 percent. Hog kill totaled 5.97 million head, down 15 percent. The average live weight increased 1 pound to 243.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 25 million pounds (11.3 thousand metric tons), was down 14 percent. Slaughter totaled 443 thousand head, down 14 percent; however, the average live weight increased 3 pounds to 114.
