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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in November 1986 totaled 2.98 billion pounds (1.35 million metric tons), down 4 percent from November 1985, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-November red meat production, at 35.8 billion pounds (16.2 million metric tons), was down 1 percent from a year earlier. The percentage changes in accumulated production by individual components were: beef, up 2; veal, up 4; pork, down 6; lamb and mutton, down 6. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for November 1986 included 20 weekdays (two were holidays) and five Saturdays. Kill days for November 1985 consisted of 21 weekdays (two were holidays) and five Saturdays.

COMPARING NOVEMBER 1986 WITH NOVEMBER 1985

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.81 billion pounds (820 thousand metric tons), was down fractionally. Head kill totaled 2.82 million, up fractionally. The average live weight decreased 6 pounds to 1097.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 37 million pounds (16.8 thousand metric tons), was down 12 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 255 thousand head, down 11 percent, and the average live weight decreased 6 pounds to 244.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.12 billion pounds (506 thousand metric tons), was down 10 percent. Hog kill totaled 6.24 million head, down 11 percent. The average live weight increased 2 pounds to 250.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 24 million pounds (10.9 thousand metric tons), was down 14 percent. Slaughter totaled 413 thousand head, down 13 percent. The average live weight increased 2 pounds to 119.
