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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in December 1986 totaled 3.26 billion pounds (1.48 million metric tons), up 4 percent from December 1985, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-December red meat production, at 39.0 billion pounds (17.7 million metric tons), was down fractionally from a year earlier. The percentage changes for 1986 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, up 3; veal, up 2; pork, down 5; lamb and mutton, down 6. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for December 1986 included 23 weekdays (one was a holiday) and four Saturdays. Kill days for December 1985 consisted of 22 weekdays (one was a holiday) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING DECEMBER 1986 WITH DECEMBER 1985

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.97 billion pounds (894 thousand metric tons), was up 6 percent. Head kill totaled 3.08 million, up 5 percent. The average live weight increased 7 pounds to 1099.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 41 million pounds (18.6 thousand metric tons), was down 11 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 289 thousand head, down 9 percent, and the average live weight decreased 6 pounds to 240.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.22 billion pounds (553 thousand metric tons), was up fractionally. Hog kill totaled 6.79 million head, down 2 percent. The average live weight increased 5 pounds to 251.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 27 million pounds (12.2 thousand metric tons), down 10 percent. Slaughter totaled 454 thousand head down 10 percent. The average live weight increased 4 pounds to 121.
