COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in January 1987 totaled 3.41 billion pounds (1.55 million metric tons), down 2 percent from January 1986, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms. Kill days for January 1987 included 22 weekdays (two were holidays) and five Saturdays. Kill days for January 1986 consisted of 23 weekdays (two were holidays) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING JANUARY 1987 WITH JANUARY 1986

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.10 billion pounds (953 thousand metric tons), was down 2 percent. Head kill totaled 3.20 million, down 4 percent. The average live weight increased 9 pounds to 1109.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 39 million pounds (17.7 thousand metric tons), was down 15 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 263 thousand head, down 15 percent and the average live weight increased 1 pound to 250.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.24 billion pounds (564 thousand metric tons), was down 2 percent. Hog kill totaled 6.92 million head, down 4 percent. The average live weight increased 4 pounds to 250.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 25 million pounds (11.3 thousand metric tons), was down 19 percent. Slaughter totaled 428 thousand head, down 17 percent. The average live weight was unchanged at 118 pounds.
