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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in May 1987 totaled 2.98 billion pounds (1.35 million metric tons), down 12 percent from May 1986, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-May red meat production, at 15.6 billion pounds (7.09 million metric tons), was down 5 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1986 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 5; veal, down 17; pork, down 5; lamb and mutton, down 11. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for May 1987 included 21 weekdays (one a holiday) and five Saturdays. Kill days for May 1986 consisted of 22 weekdays (one a holiday) and five Saturdays.

COMPARING MAY 1987 WITH MAY 1986

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.85 billion pounds (840 thousand metric tons), down 12 percent. Head kill totaled 2.87 million, down 11 percent. The average live weight decreased 15 pounds to 1087.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 32 million pounds (14.5 thousand metric tons), down 26 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 202 thousand head, down 27 percent and the average live weight increased 6 pounds to 268.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.07 billion pounds (485 thousand metric tons), down 12 percent. Hog kill totaled 6.08 million head, down 12 percent. The average live weight increased 1 pound to 247.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 22 million pounds (9.98 thousand metric tons), down 12 percent. Slaughter totaled 373 thousand head, down 14 percent. The average live weight increased 1 pound to 117.
