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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in June 1987 totaled 3.10 billion pounds (1.41 million metric tons), down 2 percent from June 1986, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-June red meat production, at 18.7 billion pounds (8.49 million metric tons), was down 4 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1986 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 4; veal, down 17; pork, down 4; lamb and mutton, down 10. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for June 1987 included 22 weekdays and four Saturdays. Kill days for June 1986 consisted of 21 weekdays and four Saturdays.

COMPARING JUNE 1987 WITH JUNE 1986

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.96 billion pounds (888 thousand metric tons), down 3 percent. Head kill totaled 3.03 million, down 3 percent. The average live weight decreased 8 pounds to 1086.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 35 million pounds (15.9 thousand metric tons), down 15 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 227 thousand head, down 12 percent and the average live weight decreased 2 pounds to 261.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.09 billion pounds (493 thousand metric tons), up 2 percent. Hog kill totaled 6.16 million head, up 1 percent. The average live weight increased 3 pounds to 248.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 24 million pounds (10.9 thousand metric tons), unchanged. Slaughter totaled 421 thousand head, up fractionally. The average live weight at 115 pounds was unchanged.
