COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in July 1987 totaled 3.16 billion pounds (1.43 million metric tons), down 4 percent from July 1986, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-July red meat production, at 21.9 billion pounds (9.92 million metric tons), was down 4 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1986 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 5; veal, down 17; pork, down 3; lamb and mutton, down 9. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for July 1987 and July 1986 are 23 weekdays (one a holiday) and four Saturdays.

## COMPARING JULY 1987 WITH JULY 1986

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.02 billion pounds (915 thousand metric tons), was down 6 percent. Head kill totaled 3.10 million, down 7 percent. The average live weight increased 2 pounds to 1093.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 34 million pounds (15.4 thousand metric tons), was down 24 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 232 thousand head, down 23 percent, and the average live weight decreased 6 pounds to 248.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.08 billion pounds (491 thousand metric tons), was up 2 percent. Hog kill totaled 6.19 million head, up 1 percent. The average live weight was unchanged at 245.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 25 million pounds (11.3 thousand metric tons), was down 4 percent. Slaughter totaled 426 thousand head, down 5 percent. The average live weight increased 4 pounds to 118.
