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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in August 1987 totaled 3.13 billion pounds (1.42 million metric tons), down 1 percent from August 1986, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-August red meat production, at 25.0 billion pounds (11.3 million metric tons), was down 4 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1986 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 4; veal, down 19; pork, down 2; lamb and mutton, down 8. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for August 1987 and August 1986 were 21 weekdays and five Saturdays.

COMPARING AUGUST 1987 WITH AUGUST 1986

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.01 billion pounds (909 thousand metric tons), was down 3 percent. Head kill totaled 3.05 million, down 5 percent. The average live weight increased 9 pounds to 1100.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 30 million pounds (13.6 thousand metric tons), was down 27 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 214 thousand head, down 23 percent, and the average live weight decreased 10 pounds to 239.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.07 billion pounds (487 thousand metric tons), was up 4 percent. Hog kill totaled 6.18 million head, up 3 percent. The average live weight was up 1 pound to 244.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 24 million pounds (10.9 thousand metric tons), was down 4 percent. Slaughter totaled 416 thousand head, down 6 percent. The average live weight increased 3 pounds to 117.
