COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in September 1987 totaled 3.33 billion pounds (1.51 million metric tons), up 2 percent from September 1986, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-September red meat production, at 28.3 billion pounds (12.9 million metric tons), was down 3 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1986 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 4; veal, down 18; pork, down 1; lamb and mutton, down 8. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for both September 1987 and September 1986 were 22 weekdays (one a holiday) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING SEPTEMBER 1987 WITH SEPTEMBER 1986

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.04 billion pounds (926 thousand metric tons), about the same as last year. Head kill totaled 3.07 million, down 2 percent. The average live weight increased 12 pounds to 1114.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 36 million pounds (16.3 thousand metric tons), down 16 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 243 thousand head, down 14 percent. The average live weight decreased 5 pounds to 250.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.23 billion pounds (557 thousand metric tons), up 8 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.03 million head, up 8 percent. The average live weight was up 1 pound to 246.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 28 million pounds (12.7 thousand metric tons), down 7 percent. Slaughter totaled 474 thousand head, down 7 percent. The average live weight increased 4 pounds to 120.
