COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in October 1987 totaled 3.53 billion pounds (1.60 million metric tons), up 1 percent from October 1986, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-October red meat production, at 31.9 billion pounds (14.5 million metric tons), was down 3 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1986 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 4; veal, down 18; pork, nearly the same; lamb and mutton, down 8. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for October 1987 included 22 weekdays (one a holiday) and five Saturdays. Kill days for October 1986 consisted of 23 weekdays (one a holiday) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING OCTOBER 1987 WITH OCTOBER 1986

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.10 billion pounds (952 thousand metric tons), down 2 percent. Head kill totaled 3.13 million, down 5 percent. The average live weight increased 15 pounds to 1118.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 37 million pounds (16.8 thousand metric tons), down 16 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 249 thousand head, down 16 percent. The average live weight was unchanged at 253 pounds.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.36 billion pounds (618 thousand metric tons), up 6 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.72 million head, up 6 percent. The average live weight was unchanged at 248 pounds.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 28 million pounds (12.7 thousand metric tons), down 7 percent. Slaughter totaled 460 thousand head, down 10 percent. The average live weight increased 4 pounds to 122.
