COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in NOVEMBER 87 totaled 3.20 billion pounds (1.45 million metric tons), up 7 percent from November 1986, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-November red meat production, at 35.1 billion pounds (15.9 million metric tons), was down 2 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1986 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 3; veal, down 18; pork up 1; lamb and mutton, down 7. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for NOVEMBER 1987 included 21 weekdays (two were holidays) and four Saturdays. Kill days for NOVEMBER 1986 consisted of 20 weekdays (two were holidays) and five Saturdays.

## COMPARING NOVEMBER 1987 WITH NOVEMBER 1986

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.83 billion pounds (830 thousand metric tons), was up 1 percent from last year. Head kill totaled 2.75 million, down 2 percent. The average live weight increased 24 pounds to 1121.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 32 million pounds (14.5 thousand metric tons), was down 14 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 223 thousand head, down 13 percent, and the average live weight was unchanged at 244.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.31 billion pounds (595 thousand metric tons), was up 17 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.32 million head, up 17 percent. The average live weight increased 1 pound to 251.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 25 million pounds (11.3 thousand metric tons), was up 4 percent. Slaughter totaled 411 thousand head, nearly the same. The average live weight increased 3 pounds to 122.
