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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in APRIL 1988 totaled 3.16 billion pounds (1.43 million metric tons), nearly the same as April 1987, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-April red meat production, at 12.8 billion pounds (5.82 million metric tons), was up 1 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1987 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 2; veal, down 14; pork up 7; lamb and mutton, up 6. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for April 1988 included 21 weekdays (no holiday) and five Saturdays. Kill days for April 1987 consisted of 22 weekdays (no holiday) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING APRIL 1988 WITH APRIL 1987

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.84 billion pounds (836 thousand metric tons), was down 4 percent from last year. Head kill totaled 2.78 million, down 6 from last year. The average live weight increased 12 pounds to 1,106.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 28 million pounds (12.7 thousand metric tons), was down 18 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 176 thousand head, down 22 percent, and the average live weight increased 13 pounds to 266.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.26 billion pounds (573 thousand metric tons), was up 8 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.09 million head, up 6 percent. The average live weight increased 3 pound to 249.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 26 million pounds (11.8 thousand metric tons), was down 10 percent. Slaughter totaled 404 thousand head, down 19 percent. The average live weight increased 10 pounds to 126.
