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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in May 1988 totaled 3.21 billion pounds up 8 percent from May 1987, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-May red meat production, at 16.0 billion pounds was up 3 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1987 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, down 1; veal, down 12; pork up 9; lamb and mutton, up 9. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for May 1988 included 22 weekdays (one a holiday) and four Saturdays. Kill days for May 1987 consisted of 21 weekdays (one a holiday) and five Saturdays.

## COMPARING MAY 1988 WITH MAY 1987

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.92 billion pounds was up 4 percent from last year. Head kill totaled 2.91 million, up 1 from last year. The average live weight increased 15 pounds to 1,102.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 30 million pounds was down 6 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 179 thousand head, down 11 percent, and the average live weight increased 14 pounds to 279.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.23 billion pounds was up 15 percent. Hog kill totaled 6.88 million head, up 13 percent. The average live weight increased 3 pounds to 250.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 27 million pounds was up 23 percent. Slaughter totaled 427 thousand head, up 14 percent. The average live weight increased 9 pounds to 126.
