COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in June 1988 totaled 3.32 billion pounds, up 7 percent from June 1987, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-June red meat production, at 19.3 billion pounds was up 3 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1987 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, unchanged; veal, down 11; pork, up 9; lamb and mutton, up 9. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for June 1988 included 22 weekdays (no holiday) and four Saturdays. Kill days for June 1987 consisted of 22 weekdays (no holiday) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING JUNE 1988 WITH JUNE 1987

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.02 billion pounds was up 3 percent from last year. Head kill totaled 3.07 million, up 1 from last year. The average live weight increased 19 pounds to 1105.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 34 million pounds was down 3 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 212 thousand head, down 6 percent, while the average live weight increased 6 pounds to 265.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.23 billion pounds was up 13 percent. Hog kill totaled 6.90 million head, up 12 percent. The average live weight increased 2 pounds to 250.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 27 million pounds was up 13 percent. Slaughter totaled 428 thousand head, up 2 percent. The average live weight increased 9 pounds to 124.
