COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in September 1988 totaled 3.46 billion pounds up 4 percent from September 1987, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-September red meat production, at 29.5 billion pounds was up 4 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1987 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, up 1; veal, down 7; pork up 10; lamb and mutton, up 7. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for September 1988 included 22 weekdays (one holiday) and four Saturdays. Kill days for September 1987 also consisted of 22 weekdays (one holiday) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING SEPTEMBER 1988 WITH SEPTEMBER 1987

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.04 billion pounds was unchanged from last year. Head kill totaled 3.01 million, down 2 from last year. The average live weight increased 16 pounds to 1130.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 33 million pounds was down 6 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 215 thousand head, down 10 percent, and the average live weight increased 11 pounds to 259.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.36 billion pounds was up 11 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.72 million head, up 10 percent. The average live weight increased 1 pound to 247.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 28 million pounds was unchanged from last year. Slaughter totaled 469 thousand head, down 1 percent. The average live weight increased 1 pound to 121.
