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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in October 1988 totaled 3.51 billion pounds nearly the same as last year, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-October red meat production, at 33.0 billion pounds was up 4 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1987 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, unchanged; veal, down 7; pork up 10; lamb and mutton, up 6. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for October 1988 included 21 weekdays (one holiday) and five Saturdays. Kill days for October 1987 consisted of 22 weekdays (one holiday) and five Saturdays.

COMPARING OCTOBER 1988 WITH OCTOBER 1987

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 2.01 billion pounds down 4 percent. Head kill totaled 2.97 million, down 5 percent from last year. The average live weight increased 17 pounds to 1,135.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 34 million pounds was down 6 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 206 thousand head, down 16 percent, and the average live weight increased 23 pounds to 274.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.44 billion pounds was up 6 percent. Hog kill totaled 8.09 million head, up 5 percent. The average live weight increased 2 pound to 250.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 28 million pounds was unchanged. Slaughter totaled 453 thousand head, down 2 percent. The average live weight, at 122 pounds, was unchanged.
