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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in November 1988 totaled 3.40 billion pounds up 6 percent from last year, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-November red meat production, at 36.4 billion pounds was up 4 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1987 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, unchanged; veal, down 7; pork up 10; lamb and mutton, up 6. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in Federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for November 1988 included 22 weekdays (two holidays) and four Saturdays. Kill days for November 1987 consisted of 21 weekdays (two holidays) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING NOVEMBER 1988 WITH NOVEMBER 1987

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.88 billion pounds up 3 percent. Head kill totaled 2.80 million, up 2 from last year. The average live weight increased 13 pounds to 1134.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 33 million pounds was up 3 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 210 thousand head, down 5 percent, and the average live weight increased 19 pounds to 262.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.46 billion pounds was up 11 percent. Hog kill totaled 8.13 million head, up 11 percent. The average live weight increased 1 pound to 252.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 27 million pounds up 8 percent from last year. Slaughter totaled 432 thousand head, up 5 percent. The average live weight increased 1 pound to 123.
