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COMMERCIAL RED MEAT PRODUCTION for the United States in December 1988 totaled 3.36 billion pounds down 1 percent from December 1987, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. January-December red meat production, at 39.8 billion pounds was up 3 percent from last year. The percentage changes from 1987 accumulated production by individual components were: beef, unchanged; veal, down 7; pork up 9; lamb and mutton, up 6. Commercial red meat production includes slaughter in federally inspected and other plants, but excludes animals slaughtered on farms.

Kill days for December 1988 included 22 weekdays (one holiday) and five Saturdays. Kill days for December 1987 consisted of 23 weekdays (one holiday) and four Saturdays.

COMPARING DECEMBER 1988 WITH DECEMBER 1987

BEEF PRODUCTION, at 1.87 billion pounds was down 3 percent. Head kill totaled 2.77 million, down 4 percent from last year. The average live weight increased 18 pounds to 1141.

VEAL PRODUCTION, at 32.0 million pounds was down 11 percent. Calf slaughter totaled 210 thousand head, down 17 percent. The average live weight increased 15 pounds to 255.

PORK PRODUCTION, at 1.42 billion pounds was up 2 percent. Hog kill totaled 7.94 million head, up 2 percent. The average live weight increased 2 pound to 251.

LAMB AND MUTTON PRODUCTION, at 29 million pounds was up 4 percent from last year. Slaughter totaled 460 thousand head, up 2 percent. The average live weight increased 2 pound to 125.
